RE: ACTUARIAL OPINION SUMMARY FILINGS (CB 2009-01)

Effective with the yearend 2008 filing, all companies authorized to write property and/or casualty insurance in Illinois must submit an Actuarial Opinion Summary (AOS) consistent with the NAIC Annual Statement Instructions for an Actuarial Opinion Summary Supplement (Sup. Inst. 22-1).

The AOS for Illinois domestic companies shall be submitted annually by March 15th. Illinois foreign companies shall submit an AOS only upon written request from the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, Division of Insurance, and if requested then within fifteen days of request, but no earlier than March 15th.

Pursuant to 215 ILCS 404(1)(a) and NAIC Annual Statement Instructions the AOS is considered a confidential document and therefore should not be sent in with the annual statement, but should be stamped "confidential" and submitted directly to:
