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State Announces Free, One-on-One Medicare Counseling Services in Mt. Sterling

Illinois Department of Insurance SHIP Counselors to Provide Help with Medicare Options During Open-Enrollment Season; Pre-Registration Required

SPRINGFIELD – November 30, 2011. Governor Pat Quinn and the Illinois Department of Insurance announce free, one-on-one counseling services in Mt. Sterling to help educate Medicare-eligible individuals and their caregivers about available insurance options. The Department's Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) is conducting a series of counseling sessions statewide to assist Medicare-eligible individuals with the Medicare open enrollment season, which runs earlier than past years, from October 15th through December 7th.

Governor Quinn proclaimed the week of October 10-15 as SHIP Week to recognize the program's hundreds of volunteers and remind Medicare-eligible residents that open enrollment begins sooner this year. Through its staff and a network of hundreds of trained volunteers in more than 204 sites throughout the state, SHIP assists Illinoisans who have questions about or problems with:

- Medicare
- Medicare supplemental insurance
- Medicare Advantage Plans (HMO,PPO, and PFFS)
- Medicare claims and appeals
- Prescription drug coverage through Medicare and other sources
- Long term care insurance

Every SHIP office is volunteer-based and supported by local sponsoring organizations. Since SHIP's inception, volunteers have provided nearly 700,000 hours of counseling, assisted more than 900,000 clients, and saved Medicare beneficiaries an estimated \$75 million in customer service costs. SHIP volunteers are also available year-round to answer Medicare questions.
