**IMPLIUCR Installation Instructions**

The downloaded WINZIP self-extracting ZIP file contains a multiple user application program interface that will help you to submit an Electronic Transmittal. Please follow the instructions below to ensure the application executes properly.

The WINZIP executable file contains:

- **IMPLIUCR.mde.** (Access application)
- **IMPLIUCR-Industry-Lookups.mde**
- **IMPLIUCR-Industry-MedMalDatabase.mde**
- **IMPLIUCR.BMP** (Title bar ICON for this application)
- **IMPLIUCR-Industry-UserGuide.pdf** ( for data entry users)
- **IMPLIUCR-Industry-ReportingRequirements.pdf** (for batch users)
- **ReportingInstructions.pdf** (for data entry and batch users)
- **MouseHook.dll**

The application provided must be loaded on to a hard drive on your IBM, or compatible microcomputer. See the following page for Additional System, Hardware, and Software requirements.

To install the **Uniform Claims Report Application**, follow these steps:

1. Create **IMPLIUCRunzip** folder on your C: drive.
2. Download/Save the self-extracting ZIP file "**IMPLIUCR-Industry-Production-Application.exe**" from the IDFPR-DOI Web Site into the **C:\IMPLIUCRunzip** folder you created.
3. **Start/Run** then **browse** for the **IMPLIUCR-Industry-Production-Application.exe** file located in the **C:\IMPLIUCRunzip** folder. Execute this file. Close window.
4. **Create a Short-Cut from your desktop OR start/program files menu to IMPLIUCR.mde to run the ACCESS 2000 Application (see your IT staff for help).**

## SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

To run the L/A&H Electronic Transmittal (ETRANS) and it's supporting components, your computer must meet the following minimum requirements:

### Hardware Requirements

- Pentium 75-Mhz (megahertz) or higher processor. (133-Mhz is recommended)
- Microsoft Windows NT Workstation version 4.0, Service Pack 3 or later.
- For Windows NT Workstation: 32 MB of RAM for the operating system, plus an additional 8 MB of RAM for Access.
- For Windows 2000 Professional: 64 MB of RAM for the operating system, plus an additional 8 MB of RAM for Access. **NOTE:** Windows 2000 requires a Pentium 133-Mhz (megahertz) or higher processor.
- CD-ROM drive.
- VGA resolution or higher video adapter.
- Super VGA (SVGA) 256-color is recommended.
- Microsoft Mouse, Microsoft IntelliMouse, or compatible pointing device.

### Software Requirements

Microsoft Access 2000 Runtime is designed to run on the following operating systems:

- Microsoft Windows NT ® Workstation version 4.0, Service Pack 3 or later
- Microsoft Windows 2000 Service Pack 3 or later.
- **The following operating systems will not be supported:**
  - o Microsoft Windows 95
  - o Windows Millennium Edition (ME)
  - o Microsoft Windows 98

### Supported Networks

Microsoft Access 2000 Runtime supports the following networks:

- Microsoft Windows NT, Windows 2000 Service Pack 3 or later.
- Novell NetWare
- **Microsoft Windows 95 will not be supported**

### Hard Disk Space

- Microsoft Access 2000 Runtime requires approximately 47.3 MB of available hard-disk space. (This number indicates a typical installation; hard-disk space requirements vary depending on configuration. Choices made during custom installation may require more or less hard-disk space.)
