Please be advised that all companies licensed to write insurance in the State of Illinois, classified in Section 4, Class 2 (c) of the Illinois Insurance Code (215 ILCS 5/4(c)), are hereby notified that they are to submit data related to medical professional liability coverage pursuant to Illinois Insurance Cost Containment Act (215 ILCS 5/1200) and Part 4203.200 of the Illinois Administrative Code (50 Ill. Adm. Code 4203.200). Companies with less than \$500,000 direct written premium on line 11 of their 2015 Illinois State Page Exhibit will be given an automatic filing exemption for 2015.

The specific section related to the Medical Malpractice data call is SUBPART B: MEDICAL MALPRACTICE REPORTING. A detailed description of the required data file format is available under Section 4203.APPENDIX A contained in SUBPART C.

All data will be submitted on either a Claims Made and/or Occurrence basis. The Department has provided templates of each data file type. The templates are available under the Medical Liability Data Call heading at: http://insurance.illinois.gov/regulatory_filings/regulatory_filings.asp.

Companies are required to utilize the appropriate templates for all of their data. The Department anticipates that most companies will use both templates.

All data files should be emailed to DOI.Costcontainment@illinois.gov on or before **May 30, 2016**. Please include the company name and "medical malpractice data call" on the subject line to insure the information is processed accurately.
