OFFICE OF FOREIGN MISSIONS' DIPLOMATIC MOTOR VEHICLE OFFICE

The purpose of this bulletin is to advise insurance producers/business entities and licensed automobile insurance companies of the services performed by the United States Department of State's Office of Foreign Missions (OFM) Diplomatic Motor Vehicle Office.

It has come to the Department's attention that many insurers as well as producers and business entities are unfamiliar with the Office of Foreign Missions. OFM's Diplomatic Motor Vehicle Office is responsible for a full range of motor vehicle services for the foreign mission community. They are responsible for driver's licensing and motor vehicle registration for foreign missions and their eligible members. Additionally, OFM is responsible for ensuring foreign missions and their eligible members carry federally mandated levels of liability insurance.

The OFM's Diplomatic Motor Vehicle Office maintains Motor Vehicle Records (MVR) for all mission members. Requests for MVRs may be submitted by faxing an individual's name, date of birth, Department of State driver's license number, a contact telephone number, and a return fax number to the local/regional OFM office. OFM maintains offices in Washington, D.C. as well as six other regional locations.
