

## **ILLINOIS PUBLIC ADJUSTERS EXAMINATION AND LICENSE INFORMATION**

A Candidate Handbook and Examination Content Outline can be found on Pearson Vue Website at <https://home.pearsonvue.com/il/insurance> which will assist you in scheduling and informing you of the examination procedures.

The examination fee of \$92.00 includes the \$50.00 State of Illinois administrative fee.

After the candidate successfully completes the public adjuster examination, he/she must submit a license application form PA-1 with a \$250.00 check payable to the Director of Insurance and provide evidence of financial responsibility in the amount \$20,000 in the form of a surety bond or letter of irrevocable letter of credit.

Before a Public Adjuster license may be issued the Public Adjuster applicant must be fingerprinted by an Illinois approved live scan vendor. No license will be issued until the Department received the results from the Illinois State Police.

### **IMPORTANT!**

Prior to conducting business as a public adjuster; compliance with Section 1501 of Illinois Insurance Code and Administrative Rule 3118 is required. You are required to submit your public adjuster contract to the Department for approval. You cannot enter into a contract with an insured until the contract is approved by the Illinois Department of Insurance.

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
